PRAYER ROOM ETIQUETTE

- In an effort to maintain high standards of health and sanitation, please wear socks and/or shoes at all times while in the prayer room.
- Please do not bring outside instruments (i.e., tambourines, hand drums, egg shakers, harmonicas, etc.) into the prayer room. Only those on the IHOP-Macon worship team for the designated set are permitted to play instruments in the prayer room.
- Please keep food items on the outside only. No food is permitted in the prayer room.
- We ask that all drinks brought into the prayer room be placed in spill-proof containers only. Please do not bring in cups from restaurants, coffee shops, convenience stores, etc. Bottled water is permitted.
- Please keep conversations in the prayer room under 30 seconds so that others are not distracted from their times of worship and prayer. If you need to have a conversation exceeding 30 seconds with someone, please do so in the foyer.
- Feel free to worship the Lord through dancing and the use of flags and banners at the back of the room. Please do not block the stage by dancing or waving banners at the front of the room.
- If you have any questions or have an immediate need, please inquire as to what staff member is on hand. They will be able to answer your questions and will assist you as best they can.
- Group prayer at IHOP Macon is facilitated by way of our corporate Intercession sets. For this reason, we ask that you do not organize small group prayer in the prayer room.
- We encourage you to make yourself comfortable in the prayer room. In doing so, please respect those around you by refraining from infringing on other's space, or making loud or distracting noises.
- If you wish to pray during an intercession (open microphone) set, please sit on the front row in the right center section of the prayer room (closest to the prayer leader stand).
 - The prayer leader will invite you to the front when the microphone is open, will assist you and let you know when it is your turn to pray.
 - Be prepared to pray from a Scripture (preferably an apostolic prayer; a list is available either in the foyer or on the front row).
 - Prayers should be kept to 5 minutes or less, if you would like the singers to assist you, simply pause and make room for them to sing during your prayer.
 - Please refrain from preaching, sharing dreams or revelation, giving prophetic words, and from praying for specific individuals by name on the microphone.
- If you wish to give an offering, there is an offering box in the bookstore area.
